

Tell the Johnston County Commissioners and Governor Perdue:

TORTURE IS NOT A VALUE OF JOHNSTON COUNTY

- Whereas, torture has critically damaged the reputation of the United States around the world and threatens the safety of our troops should they be subject to retaliation; and
- Whereas, extraordinary rendition, the practice of outsourcing torture to other countries, is unlawful; and
- Whereas, some of those rendered using planes and crews based in Johnston County are receiving monetary compensation from other nations, acknowledging that wrongs were done;

We, the people of Johnston County, urge Governor Perdue and our County Commissioners (DeVan Barbour, Tony Braswell, Jeffrey P. Carver, Allen L. Mims, Jr., Cookie Pope, Wade M. Stewart, and W. Ray Woodall) to:

- Investigate Aero Contractors, Ltd., and end its lease at the Johnston County Airport in order to prevent future flights of detainees to prisons where illegal treatment takes place, either by the Central Intelligence Agency, private contractors, or other governments; and
- Pledge that no further torture flights will be allowed to occur from our county or our state.
